## Last year:

- Over 70,000 youth and adults had increased access to health care programs, health and wellness services, and safer and healthier communities.
- **83**% of surveyed children who participated in United Way-funded early childhood education programs showed improvement in cognitive skills and 84% showed improvement in communication skills.
- Over 37,000 adults and families benefited from programs that reduced barriers to employment and provided safe and stable homes.
