"Wrapping young women and families in support, from pregnancy through early parenting, to help more babies celebrate their first birthdays."

Blanket of Love Program provides prenatal and parenting education for young women, their spouses, and friends or families. The program creates a community of support through a welcoming meal, an educational presentation and time for sharing with staff members and other members of the group.

Participants receive education on prenatal care, labor, delivery, and strategies to improve the health of the mother and the baby. Young parents receive information about their baby's development, nutritional tips, and infant care.

The program connects participants to other resources that can help lower stress, support wellness and eliminate the two most preventable causes of infant death in Milwaukee, premature births and unsafe sleeping environments.

Blanket of Love is supported by the Strong Baby Sanctuary program and planned by Ascension Columbia St. Mary's Urban Church Wellness Initiative, the City of Milwaukee Health Department, March of Dimes, and the Milwaukee Lifecourse Initiative for Healthy Families and the University of Wisconsin -- Milwaukee Maternal and Child Health Pipeline Training Program.
