Thriving Waukesha County Alliance (TWCA):

- Mission: to create long term sustainability and optimal capacity of the health and human services sector
- Comprised of: an advisory group of community members, funders, political and business leaders, Waukesha County, and nonprofit providers
- Thriving is an advocate and catalyst to build capacity, objectively facilitate community conversations, and find efficiencies and collaborative opportunities

Key Waukesha County Social Issue: Transportation

- Mission: Ensure that Waukesha County possesses a transportation system that meets the needs of those who receive and those who provide health and human services in Waukesha County.
- Spearheaded by TWCA and Interfaith Senior Programs (nonprofit provider)
- 53 individuals and 31 partners collaborating to develop a comprehensive plan (began April 2014)

- June 2014 to current: Data gathering and sharing to identify factual information to clearly define / identify areas of concern (focus groups, surveys, other)
- Central themes and key findings beginning to emerge include:
 - Lack of awareness of services
 - Lack of coordination of services
 - Critical barriers to transportation
 - Client needs may be greater than the data show
- Goal: end of June 2015 to finalize report and recommendations
- Will require coordinated and targeted funding to implement recommendations

The Transportation Affinity Group has been a community initiative collectively identifying the issues and developing a transportation solution together.
