



Partnership MKE is led by United Way of Greater Milwaukee & Waukesha County, in collaboration with the Milwaukee Jewish Federation, which aims to break down barriers and destroy bias by pairing individual community leaders across lines of race, age, religion, sexual orientation and culture. The program will guide participants through a nine-month process of relationship, understanding and trust-building, creating a blueprint on how to address and solve biases.
