The Linda McFerrin Award for African American Non-Profit Leadership was established by United Way's Board Chairman, Cory Nettles of Generation Growth Capital, Inc. and his wife Michelle Nettles, Chief People and Diversity Officer of Molson Coors Brewing Company, in recognition of Linda McFerrin, retired Vice President of Resource Development, and her 42 years of leadership and service to United Way.

Vincent Lyles was the president & CEO of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater Milwaukee for seven years and is known in the community as a strong advocate working to advance issues that help support youth in Milwaukee.

"I am so pleased that Vincent Lyles was selected to receive the inaugural Linda McFerrin Award. Vincent has been among the strongest nonprofit leaders in our community. He did a great job scaling the Boys and Girls Club of Greater Milwaukee's impact in our community," said Nettles.
